Hey Did You Know...

You can tell how busy SeaWorld is by the number of cars being run on the Skyride? Minimum number of cars, even on the slowest day, is 6. Maximum number is an astounding 25 cars!

Wild Arctic was originally a submarine simulator who's mission was to raise an ancient sunken ship "The Erebus" There was no exhibit at the end of the ride.

Journey to Atlantis has two alternating elevators raising thrill seekers inside their cars to the final plunge from Atlantis.

The Skytower first opened in 1969 and runs on 16 lifting cables.
